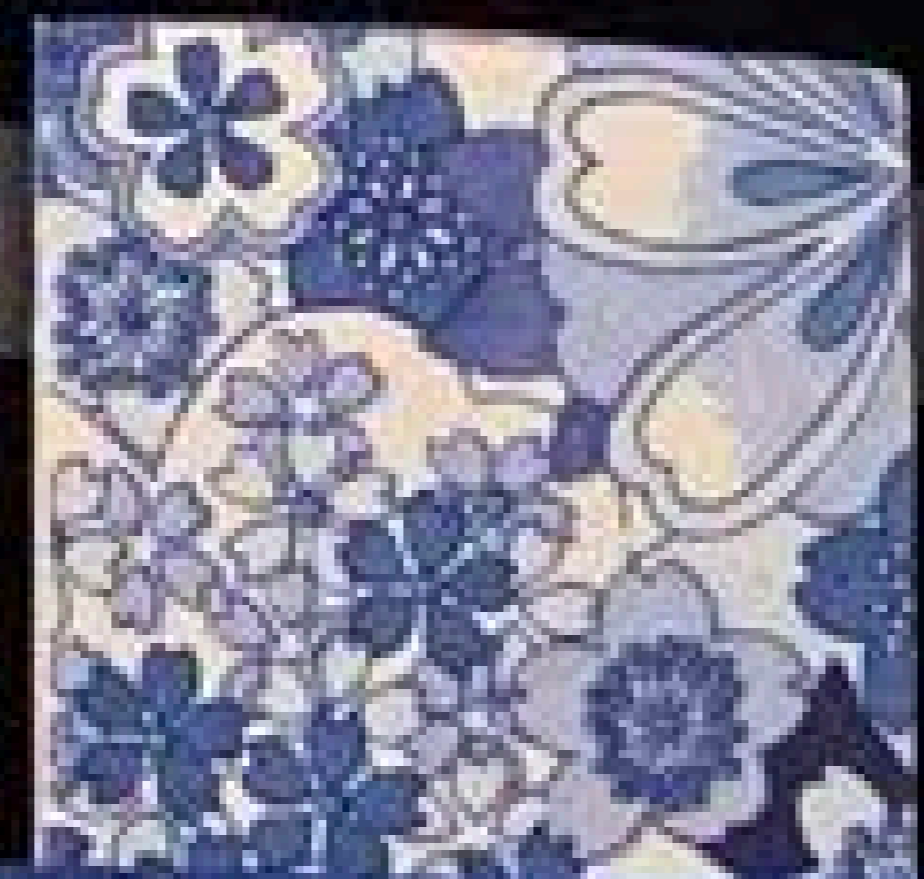


I couldn't afford to buy it.
