Regarding the civilian popula tion, the directive orders in militant tones: "You should intensify the campaign to push the people to uprise, to overthrow the enemy government, to destroy all the enemy apparatil, which especially the violent appararet apparatil. These apparatil are used by the anemy to control the people, to take over the government into the hands of the people. This is the duty of the whole (Communist) Party, the whole armed forces and the whole people. It can not be done by one group out of the three. But, if all three groups are coordinated, they will succeed. The military armed forces plays an im

"The military armed forces plays an important role in promoting the people's uprising because they are the spearhead into the enemy s areas, and so the troops should be well educated on civilian proselyting, on making propaganda and in carrying out the campaign among people living in the enemy-controlled areas."

For actions leading up to the "people's uprising," the Viet Cong soldiers and political cadre have been directed to take these seven steps:

- 2. "Help the people—not only lead the people—but buty them to it uprise—but help them to uprise to destroy the evil-deer," referring to Vietnemese government police, military and government officials.
- 3. Help the people put pressure on government posts wo the defenders will withdraw without fighting.
- 4. Push the people to uprise, encircle the post and appeal to the defenders to lay down their axus.

- 5. "When the people seement sees any enemy unit moving into position to attack you, you must help the people uprise and encircle the t unit.

 But you have to protect the people in case the puppets (Vietnamese government) shoot at the people. The people should ask the puppets to lay down their weapons or withdraw from their attacking position, so the revolutionary troops can move forward without fighting."
- 6. "Anywhere the revolutionary troops move in without fighting, they must help the people to produce foodstuffs, to build combat hamlets, to help the guerrillas improve their fighting and you must try at all times to create solidar solidarity with the people and the local guerrillas."
- 7. The Communist troops are to observe all the details of local customs and habits go they can "mobilize the people through persuasion and propaganda so they will voluntarily contribute manpower and property for the resistance in order to bring the war to an end faster and victoriously."

The Communist indectrination sessions for their troops to convert or neutralize Vietnamese government soldiers and officials is also carefully mapped out. First, the cadre Communist cadre-soldiers should know the Communist Party policy before approaching the "enemy." Second, when they understand clearly that proselytizing is the "soul of the policy," the troops are order to begin the campi campaign by practicing on other members of their unit. Third, they makkermitain begin to call on their own relatives to move from the Vietnamese government area to the Viet Cong zones. Fourth, they try to persuade friends their personal friends or former classnates or associates to join them. If the soldier-cadre can not contact his friends or relatives directly, then he must write a full report for his superiors so that other Viet Cong can contact them.

During battles with their enemy coldiers, the Viot Cong have been directed to "know how to combine the shooting with surrender appeals. You should not shoot to kill all the time, because you kill other Vietnamesm Vietnamesm. But, you should eath the enemy to surrender all the time without shooting, because he will shoot you. So you have to combine minimum equally the shooting with the surrender appeals. The shooting and killing is on the same level as surrender appeals causing the enemy to disintegrate."

The directive also states it is "categorically forbidden" to execute any defector or prisoner, which marks a change from known battlefield atrocities of last year.
