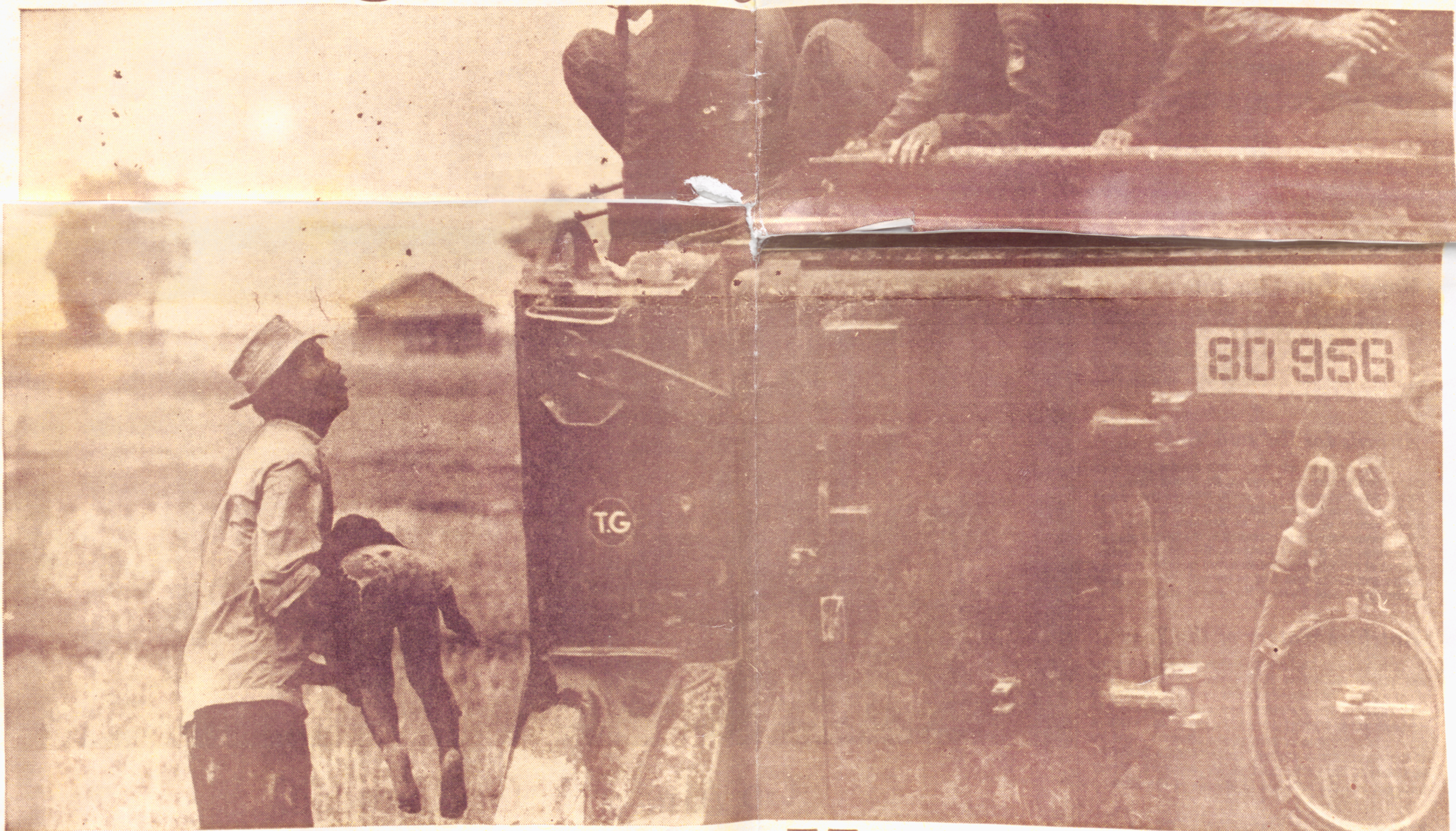


What's a nice girl like Beverly Deepe
