SA IGGS-North Victnamese toenager-troops are suspected of being drugged with opium before they initiate their frenzied battalien-sized attacks using "human wave" tactics, reliable military sources reported toda y.

The unofficial, unconfirmed reports were based on evidence that light unmarked aircraft were reportedly dropping opium supplies into Communist-infeated areas of South Viet Nam, sources said.

These opium supplies are being airdropped or landed on small plantation rurweys in the Communist-infested mountainous jungles north of Kontum, \_\_\_\_ miles north of Saigon, and close to the finger-like Communist infiltration routes called the Ho Chi Minh Freil which runs from North Vietnem through Laos 2 into South Viet Nam.

of North Vietnamese-born youth attack by newly infiltrated unit consisting of North Vietnamese-born youth attacked on the Special Forces camp at Kannack last week also increased the suspicions that these youngsters were being drugged before the batta battle. The unit of North Vietnamese—which American ground advisors said attacked in "human wave after human wave" —were defeated, leaving more than one hundred dead behind.

The reliable military sources said the reports of using opinion opinion of opinion of opinion derivatives to drug the units have not been confirmed by standard intelligence means, such as capturing a prisoner or seizing an enemy document which mentions provides evidence.

The sources said that the nationality of aircraft being used to drop opium supplies was also unknown.

In the past years, French plantament planes ar were known to be used to drop opium from Laos onto Francismum short, dirt runways masks on French p coffee or tea plantations. However, these plantations landings of opium were much closer to Saigon and this is the first suspected landing of opium in the Kontum area, which is in difficult mountain terrain, which makes it difficult to transport to the populous

other informed sources the price of anatomorphis opium has increased by more than twenty per cent in Saigon during the past two months. These sources said that the opium price jumped from 35,000 piastres per (25/500) per bild kilo to 50,000 (\$ 700) during the past two months. The original explanation given for the increase in price was that more of the opium ordering areas in Laos had slipped under Pathet Lao (Communist) control, there in the strategic of Plaines des Jarres in Laos, the scene of off-and-on battling between New American-supported Meo tribesmen and Communist Pathet Lao forces, is the most important opium producing area in Laos.

Bowever, now, some informed sources indicate that so opium prices in Saigon have increased because normal supplies from Lacs are being furneled into the Communist-infested areas of South Vietnam.

During the French Indo-China War, in which the French colonialists were defeated 11 years ago, the Communist forces launched what the French called la guerre du pavot—"the war for the poppy"—to control the optum-producing areas producing opium, which they used as a source of revenue.
